

I would like to focus my comments on the following situation.

The Main Roads (Transport) department who issue licenses do not appear to have a list of what they consider disabilities when applying for a license. Therefore if you apply and do not consider yourself to have a disability it is rather insulting to be told to get a medical certificate because they say you have one. This has happened to my son in February this year.

He was not told anything other than get a medical certificate, no other information or assistance was offered.

This is a very discriminatory practise, as firstly there is no information available and then no assistance of any sort has happened to help us apply for a drivers license.

This is a very grey area that needs some specific rules and public information.
