Dear Madam,

The Central Vic Apiarists Association wish to convey to your Inquiry, some concerns that we have regarding the implementation of Native Vegetation regulations in Central Victoria. The retention of native flora is of prime importance to our members as the majority of our honey production is from this source, both on public and private lands, and we welcome your Inquiry.

The CVAA concerns relate to what we perceive as double standards on the part of both Govt, and local Council authorities. We support current regulations protecting native vegetation including the replacement of trees removed at a 10/1 ratio, but consider that this principle should apply to all bodies, not only private landholders.

There have been numerous examples within our region of native vegetation being removed or damaged by authorities, eg, alteration or widening of roads, beside or under power lines, dump sites for road works, wild fire prevention either roadside or rail, and yet no replacement of such vegetation has been attempted.

If private landholders are expected to wear accountability, and suffer the imposition of revegetation regulations, so should local authorities, and Govt bodies. Goodwill and better compliance from landholders would be achieved if authorities in our region improved their practices.
