It was very disappointing to see the negative comments on pages 236-237 in the Draft Report re: Winlink. It seems as if the rest of the civilized world sees the merits in this store and forward email service as evidenced by their establishment of Winlink stations in many countries. The government of Australia, however, is taking a position that there is no place for this technology and service in their country,

even though there are approximately 450 amateur radio operators licensed by the government of Australia using the Winlink system today.

How can the rest of the world be wrong and Australia be right?
