This is a submission addressing, in general terms, an issue raised by others commenting on the Tasmanian Freight Subsidy Arrangements Draft Report which the Productivity Commission released on 8 Sept 2006.

- 1. There have been many uses of the word "rort" in submissions to your inquiry.
- 2. There has also been little, or no evidence of any compliance measures undertaken by the administrators of the TFES.
- 3. As a matter of urgency, routine compliance procedures such as AUDITs should be introduced into the TFES.
- 4. Just as importantly, there should be a retrospective examination of a number of past TFES claims in order to assess the occurrence of fraudulent activity, and therefore the need for a more detailed examination of past claims.
