

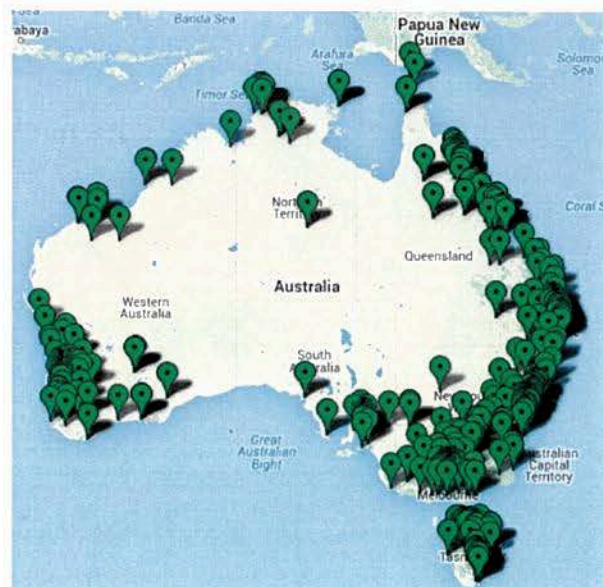

Re: Inquiry into Access to Justice Arrangements

Following our submission to the Productivity Commission last week, we created a map showing *Lawmail's* geographic reach. The map (pictured below) is available as a "zoomable" google map at <https://www.google.com/fusiontables/DataSource?docid=1VrKQp6Hjw4MIP2blj2ZJdb1VV2lhBuLTC3Xr9cA#map:id=3>. Each green flag represents legal advice given to a person in that post code since 2004.



As the map demonstrates, an electronic national legal practice has real potential to serve RRR communities. We believe the potential for reaching those communities would be enhanced if adequate and sustainable financial support was provided for services like *Lawmail*.
