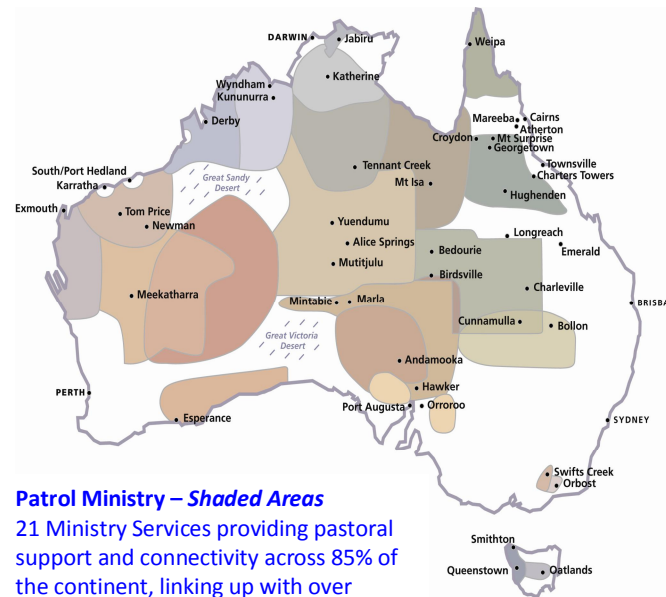

- **Rural Family Support Service:** North Queensland, Charters Towers, Hughenden - mobile outreach program – parenting support and assistance
- **Remote Area Families Services (and Children’s Services Resource Centre Mt Isa):** Mt Isa, Charleville, Emerald, Long Reach, Mareeba, – early childhood and parenting support.
- **Remote Family Care Service:** Brisbane – short term care within family, Carers placed with outback families up to three weeks pa to provide relief child care.
- **National In-Home Care:** Brisbane, includes NQ and FNQ, Charleville, WA and NT; supports contracted carers who provide child care
- **Student Group Home:** Atherton, - support for remote secondary and primary children to attend schooling.
