

IMPORTANT MESSAGE FOR CYCLISTS USING AIRPORT DRIVE

APRIL 2009

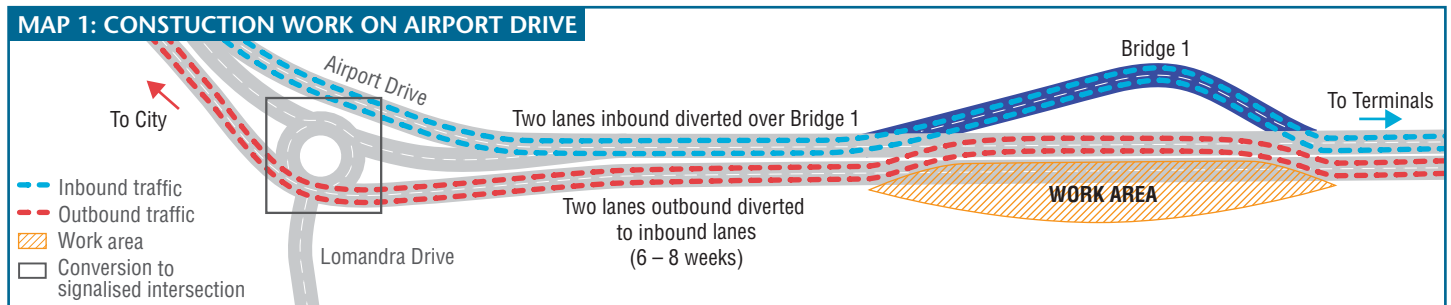
In late April / early May 2009 major changes to inbound and outbound traffic movements on Airport Drive, between Charlie Earp Bridge and the International Terminal roundabout will occur.

The work is associated with the Northern Access Road Project and the signalisation of the Airport Drive / Lomandra Drive roundabout. The changes, which are outlined on map 1 below, are:

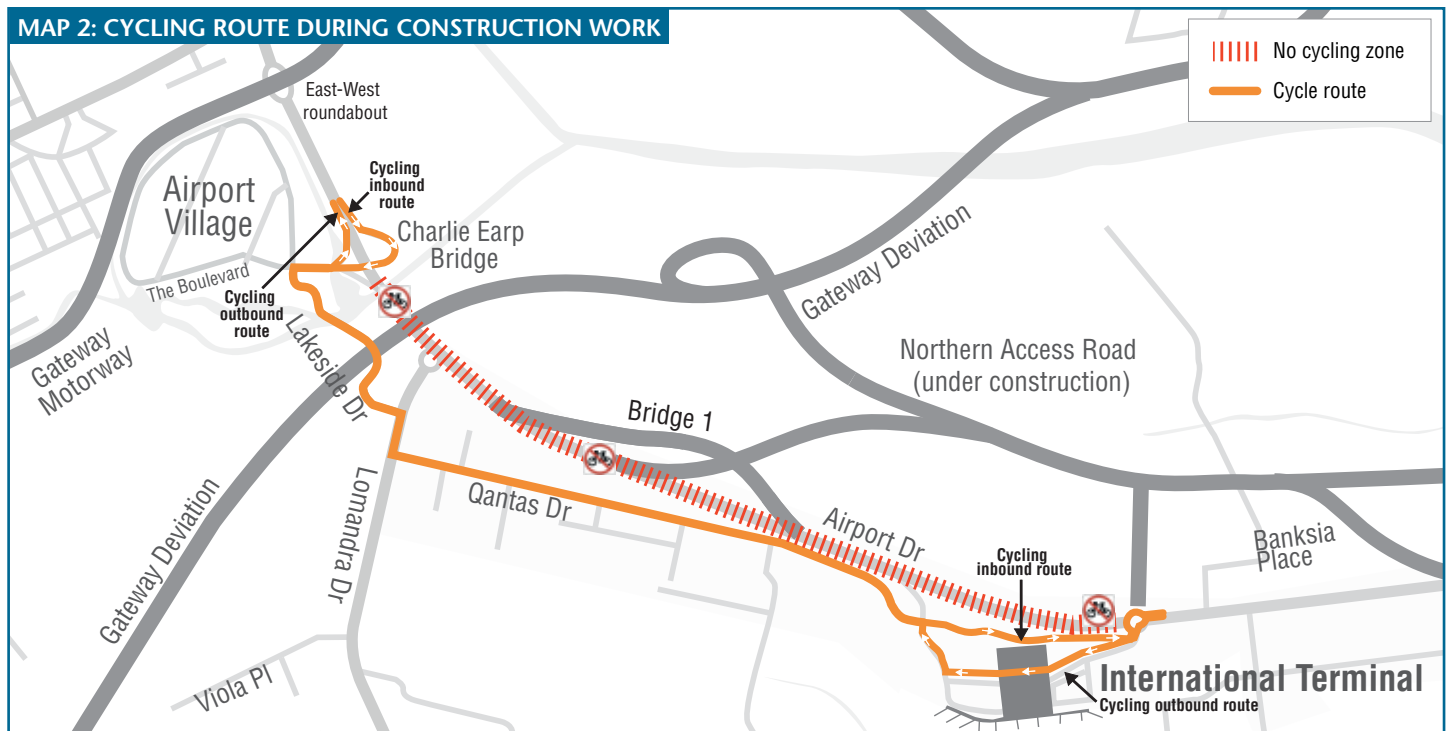
- All inbound lanes (heading towards the terminals) will be diverted onto Bridge 1.
- A section of the outbound lanes (heading towards the city) will be diverted onto the vacant inbound lanes for a period of 6 – 8 weeks.
- Lane closures in the vicinity of the Lomandra Drive / Airport Drive roundabout.
- Speed reductions will be introduced.

Work in this precinct will continue until the completion of the Northern Access Road, currently scheduled for the end of 2009.

As a result of these works and in the interests of safety, cycling on Airport Drive, between Charlie Earp Bridge and the International Terminal roundabout will be **PROHIBITED** from the date of the traffic diversion to Bridge 1 until further notice from BAC.



Understanding that cyclists travelling to and from work at the airport may not have alternative forms of transport available, BAC has designated a cycling route via Charlie Earp Bridge, Lakeside Drive and Qantas Drive that is outlined on map 2. The route will be clearly signposted ahead of the change. Notice about the specific date of the change will be provided in advance. For safety reasons it is essential that cyclists follow the designated route.
