As a long time campaigner for transport equality for surface access between Victoria and Tasmania, I ask that the Tasmanian Freight Equalisation Scheme (TFES) should be extended to cover southbound consumables and the Bass Strait Passenger Vehicle Equalisation Scheme should be expanded to offer comprehensive highway equivalence. These extensions will offer equality for consumers and allow free and fair trade between Victoria and Tasmania. They, if implemented, will deliver an Auslink type link between these two states consistent with all other inter-capital links.
