This was done in the 70's to promote water infrastructure and was very successful. We will do this because we realize all farmers are affected by droughts. So all farmers can be helped by this incentive before it happens, and not be selective with qualifying criteria to help some, after it happens.

IN RETURN ----- We will phase out Interest Subsidy as an inefficient means of help and a major disincentive for farmers to help themselves as -

- (1) It promotes "worst practice" farming i.e. To overgraze and overspend in the good times, knowing the criteria for subsidy will be met in the drought.
- (2) It is selective because of its qualifying criteria, only some droughted farmers are helped.
- (3) It is a major disincentive for "succession planning" where a major part is investing "off farm" for the future, as you will no longer meet the current criteria for interest rate subsidy help.

Blind Freddie (as long as he survived the drought) should see we must move on. We must move on , from the old " after the event "Govt. help to "before the event" self preparation with Govt. incentive.
