

You will be aware the AGO made a submission (#69) which commented on a submission by Dr Terry Williamson (#28). We have recently discovered a supplementary submission by Williamson (#78) which responds to the AGO submission.

On pages 5-7 Williamson addresses a claim from page 9 of the AGO submission: "...regulation of the thermal performance of houses influence the consumption of about 9 percent of total energy consumed in Australia." Williamson is correct in pointing out that the value should be "about 5 percent of total energy". In deriving the original figure, we were working from AGO reports that separate energy into stationary energy and fuels (i.e. mainly transport fuels). We should have said "...about 9 percent of total stationary energy consumed in Australia".
