9.2 ATM Restrictions

As soon as discussion about removing ATM machines from inside venues headed up - The Banks started locating next door to venues.

can't be always seen as main issues like yes and no.

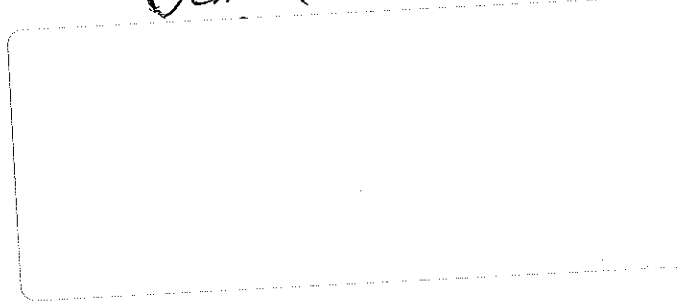
what I have said in my 5 page submission can be,

The crimes happening inside CROWN can be only 3% of the crimes happening because of the casino, after being to the casino, before going to the casino. This is too much and not too much in comparison to the total crimes and problems occurring as a result of all the gambling in VICTORIA'S venues and outlets, CROWN being one big complex but also other operations scattered outside the casino in every suburb, are causing crimes and problems.

This can only be reduced by greater protection of gamblers, the overall cost of fighting problems of gambling can be reduced, and justice including in unrelated issues can be better served, plus public satisfaction with governing bodies can improve more.

The issue applies to any rotation of governing departments and persons. Gambling is calling danger, leading by example and minimising the dangers of gambling is vital for the health of the current and next generations while politicizing such matters and commercializing causes dereliction on what the final achievement will look like.
