Re: Inquiry into Nursing Home subsidies

During proceedings before the Commission at Melbourne on Thursday 19 November, 1998, 1 undertook to provide the Commission with evidence of a recent survey conducted by this office into the status of the Nurses (Victoria Health Services) Award 1992.

The survey (attached) shows conclusively that within the 150+ Victorian Residential Aged Care Facilities who responded to the survey less than 1% of Nurses (Division 1 and 11) receive over award payments. This is contrary to the evidence of the Australian Medical Association and is thought to be more representative of the status quo in Victorian Nursing Homes and Hostels (Residential Aged Care Facilities).

As a matter of urgency, it is necessary to determine the paid rates 1 minimum rates standard of the above mentioned award as it is applied in Residential Aged Care facilities (formerly Nursing Homes and Hostels).

Your assistance is required in the completion of the attached survey to enable employers to inform the Australian Industrial Relations Commission (AIRC) of the way the award is observed by employers. This is necessary because the current application by the Australian Nurses Federation (ANF) to the AIRC to conciliate 1 arbitrate their current wage claim for nurses employed in Residential Aged Care facilities is based on the status of the award i.e. paid rate (or going rate) vs. minimum rate award.
