RURAL WATER "USE AND THE ENVIRONMENT = THE ROLE OF THE MARKET HISTORY = PALESTINE" THE INITIAL JEWISH SETTLERS SENT TO PALESTINE BY LORD BALFOUR IN THE POST-BRITISH RAJ DAYS.
