


CHILDREN'S SERVICES (CHAPTER 3)

- The focus of this chapter is on government funded and/or provided child care and preschool services for children aged 12 years or younger.
- In the March quarter 2011, 945 534 children aged 12 years or younger attended Australian Government approved child care services. In 2010-11, 117 615 children attended State and Territory funded and/or provided child care services and 224 699 children were enrolled in State and Territory funded and/or provided preschool services **(p. 3.11)**.
- Total Australian, State and Territory government expenditure on children's services was approximately \$5.4 billion in 2010-11 **(p. 3.9)**.

Objectives of children's services

- Children's services aim to:
 - meet the care and education needs of all children in developmentally appropriate ways, in a safe and nurturing environment
 - provide support for families in caring for their children
 - provide these services across a range of settings in an equitable and efficient manner.
