



# HOW TO FIND WHAT YOU NEED IN RoGS

This guide is to assist you with navigating the **Report on Government Services** web pages to find the information you need.



The RoGS is made up of 7 parts containing 19 sections. The titles of the sections indicate the service areas covered. This guide applies to part F (traditional format). Parts B, C, D, E and G (new dynamic format) have a separate guide.

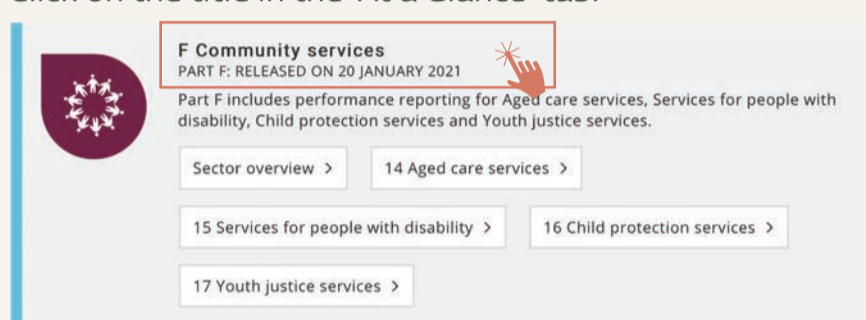

### Access a part

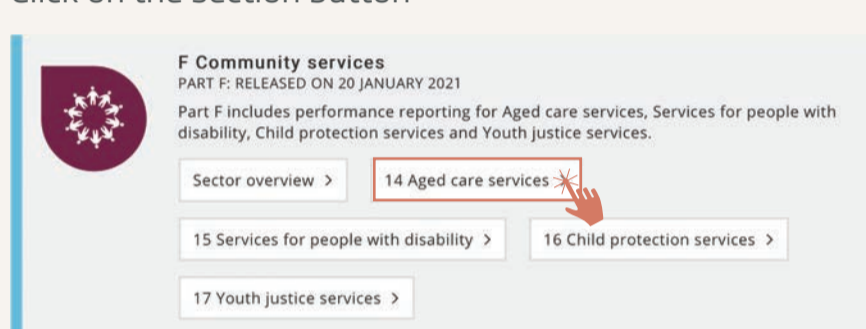
Click on the title in the 'At a Glance' tab:

### Download information within sections

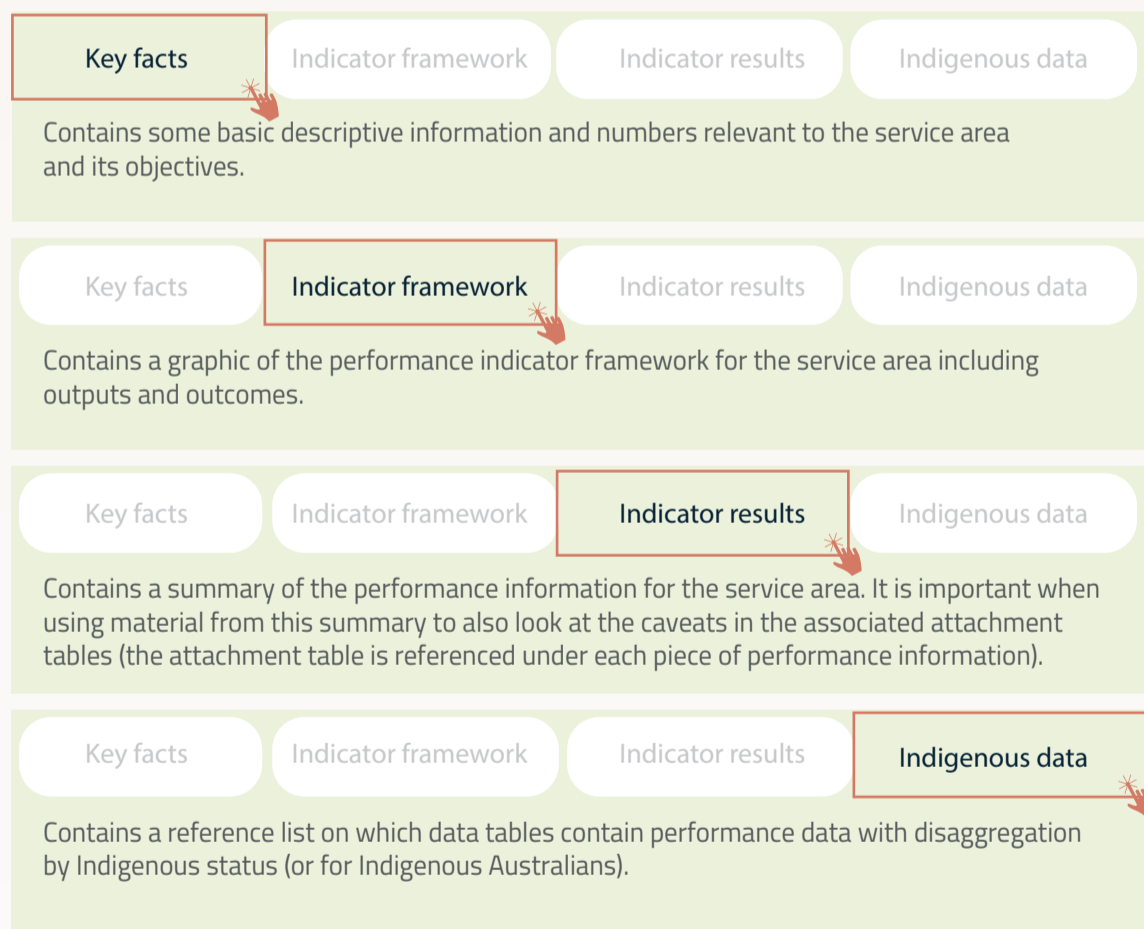
Each section page contains the following information:

- PDF containing the section and data tables.
- The section in Word containing performance and contextual information and selected data
- Excel tables containing all performance and contextual data referred to in the sections.

### Read more within the section tabs

Each section page contains further information as HTML within tabs:



## Step 6.

### Navigate within the service sections (PDF and Word)

There is a generic structure within each section which includes the following:



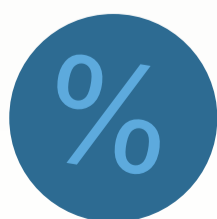
#### Profile of the service

Provides important contextual information to understand the service area and the performance results.



#### Framework of performance indicators

This lists the objectives for the service area and a figure of the indicator framework (as per the Indicator framework tab on the section web page).



#### Key performance indicator results

This provides information on the performance for each indicator in the framework drawing on the data in the attachment tables. It is important in interpreting these results to consider the associated indicator interpretation boxes in the section and the associated attachment tables (both are clearly referenced in the section).
