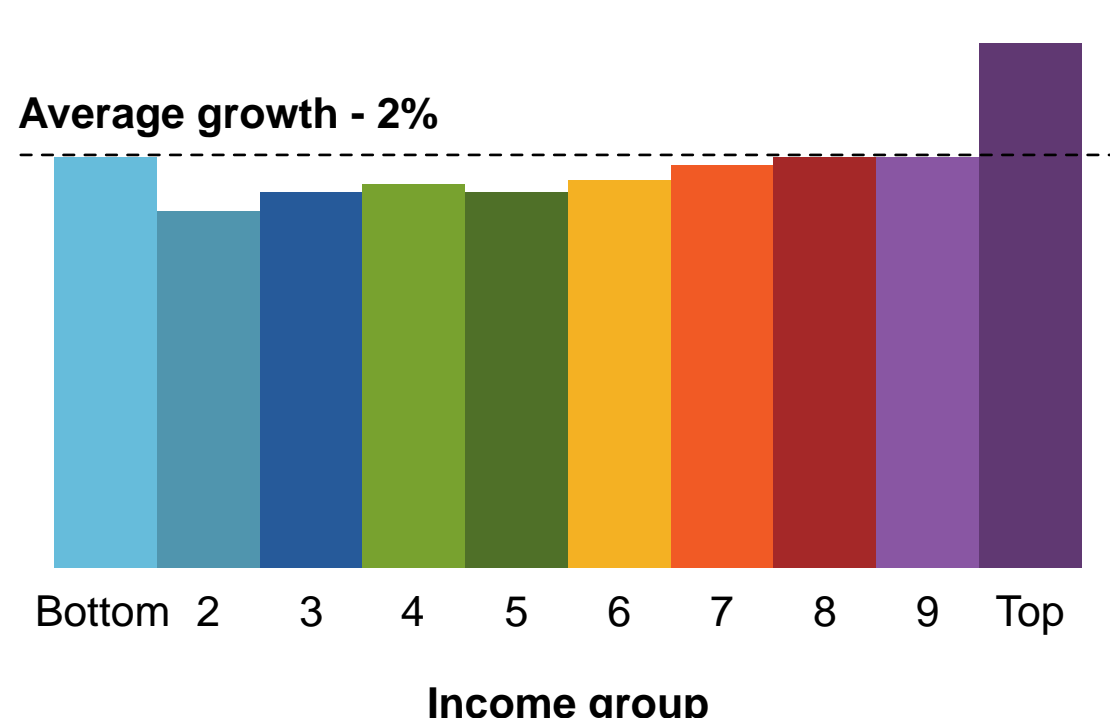

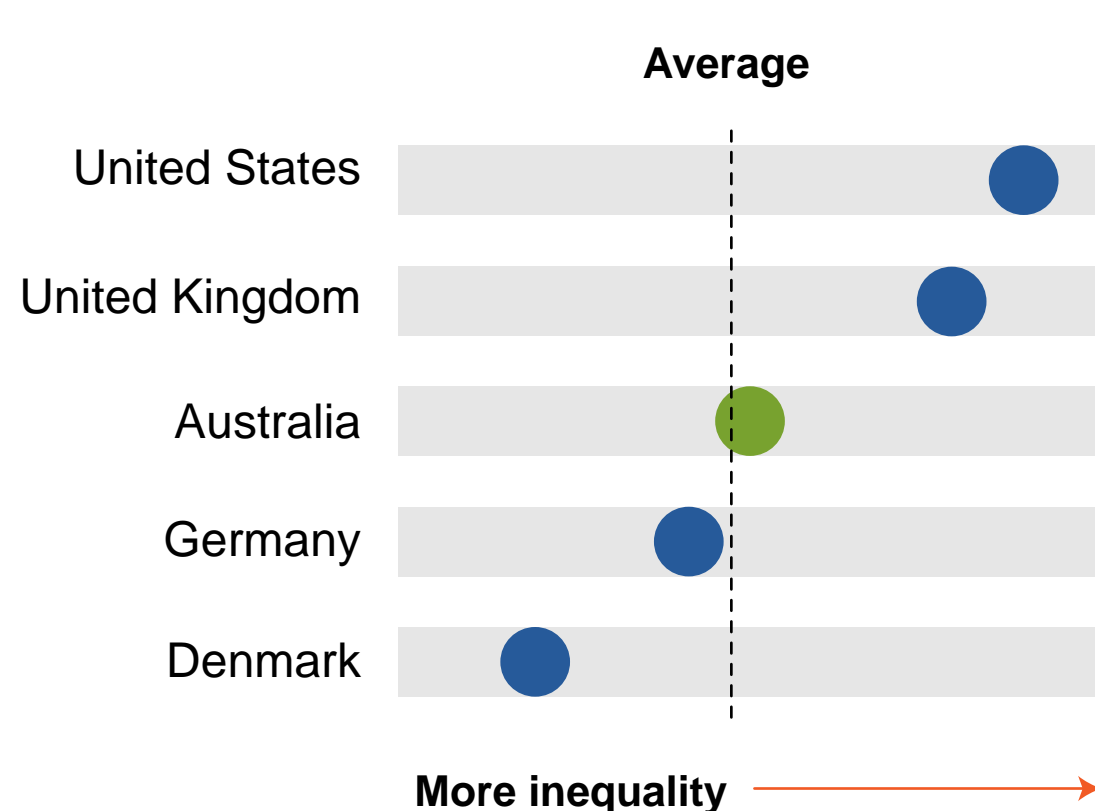
Australia has had sustained economic growth,

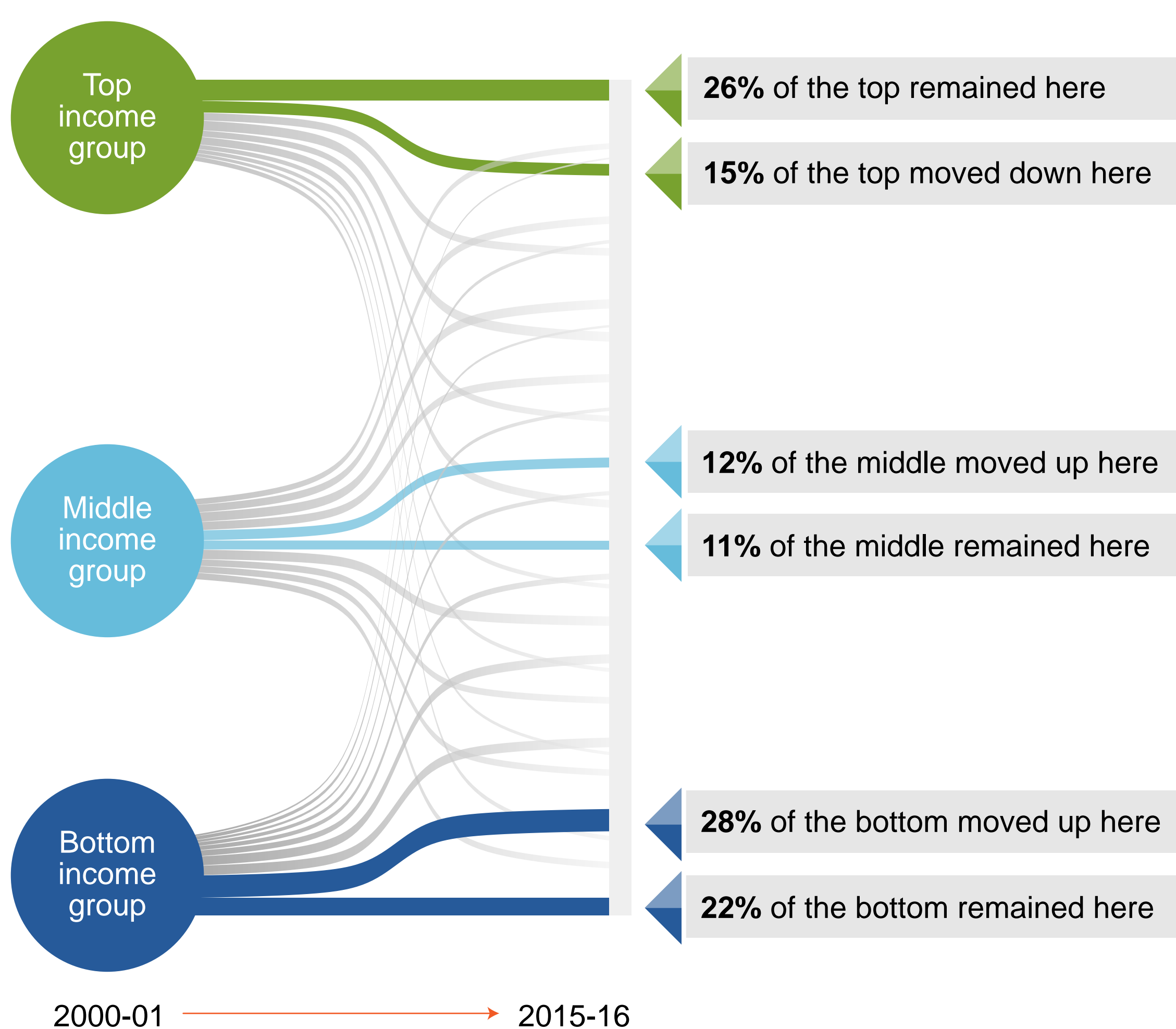
