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


Priorities

- Increase market sector coverage
 - ABS MFP's 12 market sectors cover only 2/3 of economy
 - DL cover 16 sectors and 95% of economy but with some output measurement problems in the additional sectors
 - Need to ensure increased diversity and quality is captured
- Improve quality of industry level National Accounts estimates
 - Implausible results for many sectors
 - Need to reconcile firm-based and NA sectoral TFP results
 - Increasing policy importance, eg recent MCE recommendation


Australia EGW Sector Total Factor Productivity




New Zealand EGW Sector Total Factor Productivity
